easyJet MPL

Successful applicants to the MPL in partnership with easyJet will be invited to join the Multi-crew Pilot License (MPL) route – an Airline Pilot career program at the leading edge of Airline Pilot training.

Selected and mentored by easyJet from day one, you will embark upon a unique route of training which will take you directly to the role of Co-Pilot on Airbus A320 aircraft, flying easyJet routes around Europe.

easyJet MPL Upgrade

For those who perform to an excellent standard through selection, but are initially not offered a place on the MPL, we offer the opportunity to be selected for the **MPL upgrade**.*

Following completion of ATPL Theoretical Knowledge exams to the easyJet standard, the highest performers who also meet the required academic criteria for the easyJet MPL will be selected to upgrade and continue their training along the easyJet MPL route.

*Subject to eligibility and easyJet's operational requirements. Limited availability.

easyJet Integrated ATPL

This route provides a further opportunity to join easyJet for those who successfully complete selection and join the L3 Airline Academy Integrated ATPL, but are not selected for the MPL upgrade.

This easyJet-focused route includes easyJet specific intermediate phase of training tailored to easyJet A320 aircraft and Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) and concludes with easyJet A320 type rating.

Finance & Funding

The funding required for the complete **easyJet MPL** is £109,000. This comprises:

- Security Bond - £69,000 (paid in 13 instalments)
- MPL Training Fee 1 – £40,000 (paid in two instalments, includes easyJet A320 type specific training)

The funding required for the complete **easyJet Integrated ATPL** is £123,800. This comprises:

- Training Security Bond – £69,000 (13 instalments)
- Foundation Training Fee – £24,800 (including applicable sales taxes) (paid before the commencement of Leg 3 training)
- Type rating Training – £30,000

Entry Criteria

To apply for the Generation easyJet Pilot Training Program, you must meet the following requirements:

- be at least 17 years of age to apply and 18 years of age to start training
- have the unrestricted right to live and work in the EEA or Switzerland

- hold a minimum of 5 GCSEs (or equivalent) Grade C or above, including maths, science and English language
- hold a minimum of 2 A-levels with predicted or achieved grades of C and above (*excluding general studies and critical thinking*) Please be aware that if you are offered a place on the program, you will not be able to begin until you are awarded your final grades.
- be fluent in English (verbal and written)
- produce a Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) certificate before training can commence
- minimum height 157cm, maximum height 191cm
- be able to obtain an EASA Class 1 Medical without restrictions
